

These guidelines are intended to preserve and enhance the special character of downtown Clarksville by encouraging rehabilitation and new construction that is sensitive to the existing urban form. The guidelines recognize that no single architectural style predominates, and the guidelines allow for the creativity in the design of individual buildings. However, there are certain established urban design and architectural principles shared by most properties within the district which give it a cohesive character and strong sense of place.
